This year's Health Team ushered in a new phase of building together on the foundation of international partnerships already established.

Part of that new phase of planning for a strategic medical/surgical team which will be part of the launch of the new hospital has already begun.

Training programs will be the next step whereby our external partners will transfer skills to the Leyaata Hospital staff and other health professionals in Ghana and West Africa.

Future missions will incorporate hernia repair (*to help reduce the enormous list of patients requiring hernia surgery*), eye care (*laser treatment to prevent blindness*), dental care and more.
